

**AMENDMENT #18 TO STATE OF IOWA PLAN #2 FOR DISASTER RECOVERY
Utilizing Funding from the Supplemental Appropriations Act (Public Law 110-329), 2008**

The purpose of this amendment is to reallocate funds within the Action Plan 2 budget, recognizing the fulfillment or decreased needs under several activities while responding to additional needs beyond the current allocations among others. The amendment reduces funding for several activities and restores a portion of administration funds.

Amendment to METHOD OF DISTRIBUTION (Page 8)

At Activity A., Housing repair/rehabilitation, homebuyer assistance, and interim mortgage assistance, change item 1 to read as follows:

1. Allocation for Activity: Amendment # 17 reduced the amount under this activity by \$1,292,256. Amendment #18 reduces the amount under this activity by \$159,282. This brings the total allocated for this activity under Action Plan # 2 to \$14,044,103 and the grand total for the activity under Action Plan # 1 and Action Plan # 2 to \$42,192,401.

This activity under Plan 2 is considered completed. At our direction, subrecipients conducted extensive outreach activities within their respective geographic areas, to seek and assist all eligible households. Application periods for assistance have expired. Our subrecipients have confirmed that there are no unresolved applications, nor any remaining obligations. Therefore this balance is the sum total to be spent on this activity among subrecipients for this program.

At Activity C., Housing and Commercial Buyouts –FEMA Match

1. Allocation for Activity: Amendment #17 reduced the amount under this activity by \$1,253,600. Amendment #18 reduces the amount under this activity by \$572,562. This brings the total allocated to this activity to \$10,953,216 under Action Plan 2. \$4,991,048 is allocated to this activity under Action Plan #1, bringing the grand total to \$15,944,264.

At Activity D., Housing and Commercial Property Buyouts – non-FEMA, change item 1 to read as follows:

1. Allocation for Activity: Amendment #17 reduced the amount under this activity by \$35,095,245. Amendment #18 reduces the amount under this activity by \$775,332. This brings the total allocated for this activity under Action Plan # 2 to \$170,243,622. No funds were allocated for this activity under Action Plan # 1.

At Activity E., New Housing Production, change item 1 to read as follows:

1. Allocation for Activity: \$46,866,390 was allocated to this activity under Amendment #17. Amendment 18 reduces the amount under this activity by \$837,512. This brings the total allocated for this activity under Action Plan # 2 to \$235,225,110. The grand total for the activity under Action Plan # 1 and Action Plan # 2 is \$297,783,670.

At Activity K., Public Infrastructure – Non-FEMA, change item 1 to read as follows:

1. Allocation for Activity: \$1,048,603 was allocated to this activity under Amendment #17. Amendment 18 reduces the amount under this activity by \$176,960 which brings the total allocated for this activity under Action Plan #2 to \$145,780,435. The grand total for the activity under Action Plan #1 and Action Plan #2 is \$170,809,001.

At Activity P., Planning Grants, change item 1 to read as follows:

1. Allocation for Activity: Amendment #17 reduced the amount under this activity by \$88,775. Amendment 18 reduces the amount under this activity by \$90. This brings the total allocated for this activity under Action Plan #2 to \$866,845. No funds are allocated to this activity in Action Plan 1.

At Activity V., Planning Grants for Section 106, change Allocation for Activity to read as follows:

1. Allocation for Activity: \$500,000 is allocated to this activity under Amendment #12 to Action Plan 2. Amendment 18 reduces the amount under this activity by \$9,600. This brings the total allocated for this activity under Action Plan 2 to \$490,400. No funds are allocated to this activity under Plan 1.

At Activity W., State and Local General Administration, change Allocation for Activity to read as follows:

1. Allocation for Activity: Actual expenses up to 5% of all CDBG disaster funds received by the State, less \$1 million, are allocated to this activity. \$402,032 is allocated to this activity under Amendment #10. Amendment 17 reduced the amount under this activity by \$8,500,000. Amendment #18 restores \$2,531,338 to this activity. This brings the total allocated for this activity under Action Plan # 2 to \$29,740,269, and the grand total for the activity under Action Plan # 1 and Action Plan # 2 to \$37,574,810.
