Disaster Damage:

THE EFFECT OF THE DISASTERS AND IOWA'S RECOVERY NEEDS In the late spring and early summer of 2008, the State of Iowa suffered through a series of disastrous events, tornados followed by record-breaking floods. In some cases, the same community was hit by both events. Also, in some Iowa communities the 2008 flood crested 8 feet higher than the flood of 1993. Among the larger communities, Cedar Rapids, Iowa's second-largest city, was especially hard hit. It is estimated that 1300 blocks in Cedar Rapids were flooded to the point that repair/rehabilitation will be difficult to impossible in many of those areas. It is estimated that, statewide, over 21,000 housing units have been damaged, with over 4200 of those destroyed or suffering major structural damage. Also, an estimated 2400 businesses were damaged physically, and another 3000+ have suffered economic losses. It is quite clear that FEMA and SBA assistance will not come close to covering all of the uninsured costs associated with the damage.

Recovery Needs:

Following are estimates of damages compiled by the Rebuild Iowa Advisory Commission in just three community/economic development categories. This summary consists of the combined list of projects related to disaster recovery that were applied for, but not funded, under a variety of

programs. This list was edited to avoid duplications. The total cost of the needed projects was \$1.455 Billion. - An updated estimate of unmet housing needs made by the Iowa Finance Authority in November, 2008. The estimate for unmet needs for housing was \$956 Million.

An updated estimate of unmet business needs made by the Iowa Department of Economic Development in December, 2008. The estimate for unmet business needs was \$962 million.

Overall Progress Narrative:

The B-08-DI-19-0001 (Ike) grant was committed to a variety of activities including housing repair/rehabilitation, housing buy-outs, business assistance, infrastructure, planning, watershed projects, etc. IEDA continues to work with recipients to close out all completed activities. IEDA is working closely with Recipients and Multi-family project developers to ensure successful completion of two projects that were delayed/altered as a result of a fire and a bankruptcy. The project destroyed by Fire, completed the environmental review record with quarter and was issued the Release of Funds prior to re-starting construction. The contractor has begun construction on the site and the project is moving forward. The bankruptcy project has seen advancement in final

ownership of the property to the bank. IEDA will work with the bank to obtain bids for construction completion. Both projects are anticipated to be completed by Q4 2021 with final lease-up in Q2 2022. Monitoring and closeout are expected to continue over the next quarter as well.

Disaster Damage:

THE EFFECT OF THE DISASTERS AND IOWA'S RECOVERY NEEDS In the late spring and early summer of 2008, the State of lowa suffered through a series of disastrous events, tornados followed by record-breaking floods. In some cases, the same community was hit by both events. Also, in some lowa communities the 2008 flood crested 8 feet higher than the flood of 1993. Among the larger communities, Cedar Rapids, Iowa's second-largest city, was especially hard hit. It is estimated that 1300 blocks in Cedar Rapids were flooded to the point that repair/rehabilitation will be difficult to impossible in many of those areas. It is estimated that, statewide, over 21,000 housing units have been damaged, with over 4200 of those destroyed or suffering major structural damage. Also, an estimated 2400 businesses were damaged physically, and another 3000+ have suffered economic losses. It is quite clear that FEMA and SBA assistance will not come close to covering all of the uninsured costs associated with the damage.

Recovery Needs:

Following are estimates of damages compiled by the Rebuild Iowa Advisory Commission in just three community/economic development categories. (The full reports from the Commission are available at http://rio.iowa.gov/) Economic and Workforce Development **Total estimated unmet need for small and intermediate businesses - \$2.78 billion »» \$5.36 billion total assessed damage. »» Approximately 4,800 non-manufacturing small businesses and 800 intermediate businesses were impacted. **Large businesses experienced an estimated \$100 million in losses. **Small business and non-profit corporations \$600 million in lost revenue in one year in the Cedar Rapids area, according to a report from Iowa Commercial Realty in Cedar Rapids. **Physical damage to businesses from a Safeguard lowa online survey - \$426,011,267; economic loss -\$178,593,361. **Manufacturing damages and lost income from the ISU Center for Industrial Research and Service (CIRAS) survey - \$100 million projected. **Increase in unemployment rate from Iowa Workforce Development data – 3.9% in May; 4% in June; 4.3% in July, 4.6% in August. **Initial claims for unemployment insurance program - increased by over 6,500 (over 44% increase) from May to June 2008, according to Mass Layoffs Statistics. The B-08-DI-19-0001 (Ike) grant was committed to a variety of activities including housing repair/rehabilitation, housing buyouts, business assistance, infrastructure, planning, watershed projects, etc.

IEDA continues to work with recipients to close out all completed activities. IEDA is working closely with Recipients and Multi-family project developers to ensure successful completion of two projects that were delayed/altered as a result of a fire and a bankruptcy. The project destroyed by Fire, completed the environmental review record with quarter and was issued the Release of Funds prior to re-starting construction. The contractor has faced some material and supply issues and is currently re-bidding the work. Construction is anticipated to commence in Q3 2021. The bankruptcy project has seen advancement in final ownership of the property to the bank. IEDA will work with the bank to obtain bids for construction completion. This will require the re-obligation of remaining CDBG-DR funds under this grant, in the coming quester. Both projects are anticipated to be completed by Q1 2022 with final lease-up in Q2 2022.

Monitoring and closeout are expected to continue over the next quarter as well.

Disaster Damage:

THE EFFECT OF THE DISASTERS AND IOWA'S RECOVERY NEEDS In the late spring and early summer of 2008, the State of lowa suffered through a series of disastrous events, tornados followed by record-breaking floods. In some cases, the same community was hit by both events. Also, in some lowa communities the 2008 flood crested 8 feet higher than the flood of 1993. Among the larger communities, Cedar Rapids, Iowa's second-largest city, was especially hard hit. It is estimated that 1300 blocks in Cedar Rapids were flooded to the point that repair/rehabilitation will be difficult to impossible in many of those areas. It is estimated that, statewide, over 21,000 housing units have been damaged, with over 4200 of those destroyed or suffering major structural damage. Also, an estimated 2400 businesses were damaged physically, and another 3000+ have suffered economic losses. It is quite clear that FEMA and SBA assistance will not come close to covering all of the uninsured costs associated with the damage.

Recovery Needs:

Following are estimates of damages compiled by the Rebuild Iowa Advisory Commission in just three community/economic development categories. The B-08-DI-19-0001 (Ike) grant was committed to a variety of activities including housing repair/rehabilitation, housing buyouts, business assistance, infrastructure, planning, watershed projects, etc.

IEDA continues to work with recipients to close out all completed activities. IEDA is working closely with Recipients and Multi-family project developers to ensure successful completion of two projects that were delayed/altered as a result of a fire and a bankruptcy. For the project destroyed by Fire, the contractor has faced some material and supply issues and is currently finalizing construction contracts and commencing work. The bankruptcy project has seen advancement in final ownership of the property to the bank, and IEDA is in conversations about the completion of the building. Due to some delays, projects are currently anticipated to be leased by end of Q3 2022.

Monitoring and closeout are expected to continue over the next quarter as well.

Disaster Damage:

THE EFFECT OF THE DISASTERS AND IOWA'S RECOVERY NEEDS In the late spring and early summer of 2008, the State of lowa suffered through a series of disastrous events, tornados followed by record-breaking floods. In some cases, the same community was hit by both events. Also, in some lowa communities the 2008 flood crested 8 feet higher than the flood of 1993. Among the larger communities, Cedar Rapids, Iowa's second-largest city, was especially hard hit. It is estimated that 1300 blocks in Cedar Rapids were flooded to the point that repair/rehabilitation will be difficult to impossible in many of those areas. It is estimated that, statewide, over 21,000 housing units have been damaged, with over 4200 of those destroyed or suffering major structural damage. Also, an estimated 2400 businesses were damaged physically, and another 3000+ have suffered economic losses. It is quite clear that FEMA and SBA assistance will not come close to covering all of the uninsured costs associated with the damage.

Recovery Needs:

Following are estimates of damages compiled by the Rebuild Iowa Advisory Commission in just three community/economic development categories.
